Great and Little Shelford were twinned with Verneuil-en-Halatte in the Department of Oise, France, at ceremonies held in September 1988 in France and in April 1989 in Shelford. The object of the Shelford Twinning Association is to foster friendship and understanding between the people of Great and Little Shelford and Verneuil-en-Halatte.

Membership of the Association is open to anyone interested in supporting this international link, whether they live in the Shelfords or not. The annual subscription is £10 for a family (including children under 18), or £7 for a single adult, and is payable at the time of the Annual General Meeting in May.
